- Members must first and foremost respect the physical integrity of all divers, assistants, supervisors and personnel involved in dive operations, as well as the environment.
- To work so that the diving industry has high standards of respect, fellowship and solidarity throughout the world.
- Their actions will be based on honesty, justice, dignity, respect and integrity in all aspects of business relationships.
- Do not allow situations of intimidation, harassment, discrimination and exploitation in the workplace.
- To report through the correct procedures, any breach of the rules and safe diving practices.
